

Emergency Phone

The Scout Oath is "Be Prepared." Part of being prepared is knowing what to do in the case of a serious accident, illness or fatality during Scouting trips, activities, and campouts.

Effective **Jan 1, 2007**, a dedicated phone line has been established to report these emergencies and will be manned 24hours a day. The emergency phone number is **405-219-6427**.

A reportable injury or serious illness includes:

- Any period of unconsciousness
- Any hospital inpatient admission
- Any surgical intervention other than suturing of the skin or setting of simple fractures

Reportable fatalities include:

- Those due to natural causes (e.g. heart attacks), accidents, suicides and homicides.

Information needed at the time of reporting: name of person reporting, name of injured party, when, where, what, how (if known), type of injury, and complete parent (guardian) contact information.
